# Kicking Health Goals with Sports Clubs



Healthy Canteens Project Pilot Summary July 2016 - June 2017

### SETTING THE SCENE

Sports clubs play a central role in communities providing an innovative setting to support health and wellbeing. Canteens in sports clubs often provide unhealthy food options, indicating a leverage point for intervention.

Collectively City of Casey and Monash Health established Healthy Canteens, aimed to increase healthy options in canteens by building the capacity of club influencers to identify and embed healthy changes.

#### **MAKING IT HAPPEN**

A framework was created to support clubs to work towards the healthy choices guidelines (Healthy choices: food and drink classification guide, 2015). Three Casey clubs participated in a pilot over a 4 week period. Support for healthy changes was provided by Health Promotion Practitioners, Sport and Recreation Officers and a Dietitian.

Evaluation of the pilot boasted success. Reflection identified ways to enhance the project and support amplification. New clubs in Casey are participating and expansion into Cardinia is planned.
